COVID-19 Precautions at FDL Dermatology

We at FDL Dermatology are doing our part to minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our community.

We are regularly disinfecting surfaces (doorknobs, chairs, writing utensils, keyboards, tools, etc.) as well as sanitizing all exam room equipment between patients.
